	O'sulloc Green Tea Museum	11:20~12:20	At the O'sulloc Museum, not only can visitors enjoy unique o'sulloc teas, but they can relax next to the lotus pond in the indoor garden. The second floor of the building has an observatory, so visitors can enjoy the views of the nearby green tea fields and the surrounding landscape.

	Jeju Stone Park	09:40~11:00	Jeju Stone Park is an ecological and cultural park that displays the history of stone culture pivotal to the history and culture of Jeju Island. Following the exhibition pathway, visitors will find stone sculptures such as Grandmother Seolmundae and Five Hundred Generals and traditional local thatched-roof houses amidst the forest.
	Seongeup Folk Village	11:20~12:00	Located at the foot of Mt. Halla on Jeju Island, Seongeup Folk Village is a small town that holds a vast amount of culture. The Seongeup Folk Village shows the unique culture of Jeju Island: the black lava rock walls, and the stone grandfather statues(Harubang), which have become a prime feature of the landscape.

About an hour in the length, the program introduces you about kimchi, and after you've finished preparing and seasoning your kimchi, you'll get to reward yourself by sampling the kimchi along with rice and steamed pork.
	Jeolmul Natural Forest Resort		Jeju Jeolmul Natural Recreation Forest in Jeju Island is located northeast of Hallasan Mountain. Jeolmuloreum is famous for its beautiful Japanese cedar forest. Jeolmuloreum is about 697m high above the sea level and created by volcanic activity. The peak of Jeolmuloreum boasts amazing view. It is even possible, during the clear weather, to see Ilchulbong Sacred Mountain

	Seongsan Sunrise Peak	14:10~15:40	Seongsan Sunrise Peak rose from under the sea in a volcanic eruption over 100,000 years ago. Located on the eastern end of Jeju Island, there is a huge crater at the top of Seongsan Sunrise Peak. The crater is about 600m in diameter and 90m high with the 99 sharp rocks surrounding the crater. This was designated by UNESCO as World Nature Heritage in 2007, and named a New 7 Wonder in 2011.
	Manjanggul Lava Tube	16:10~17:10	The Manjanggul Lava Tube is located in Gimnyeong-ri, Gujwaeup, Jeju City and is 23 m in breadth and 30m in height. As the lava tube stretches for as far as an approximate 7,400 m, its length ranks amongst the top 15 in the world. It is also the largest lava tube in Jeju island. It is regarded as having significant scientific and heritage value, owing to its excellent condition of preservation despite its age of formation (about 300,000 to 200,000 years ago).

	Eco Land Theme Park	14:10~15:40	Eco Land Theme Park is built in the 1km ² Gotjawal primeval forest. Visitors can explore around in a train that looks like 1800s' steam powered Baldwin train. In the large Gotjawal forest with railway trails, visitors can see a variety of plants, animals, while touring around by the special train. There are many things to enjoy including Eco Bridge, Hovercraft, Eco Windmill, Picnic Garden, Eco Road, Bare Foot on Scoria, Floating Café, and topiary art works.
	Hamdeok Beach	16:10~17:10	The clear waters that are highlighted with cobalt-blue and the clean sand of Hamdeok Beach steal the hearts of visitors every year. The beach is popular with fishermen who enjoy rope fishing from the rocks. This area is known to be good for catching striped beakfish and spotty belly greenlings.

	Lee Jung Seop Street	14:10~15:00	Artist Lee Jung-seop is known for his paintings, reminiscent of Fauvism, including one called "White Ox." During the Korean War, he spent a year as a refugee in Seogwipo with his Japanese wife and two sons in a small leased house, where he produced many masterpieces. Recognizing his importance, the city of Seogwipo purchased the house and turned it into the Art Gallery. The street in front of his house, which he walked day and night, was renamed Lee Jungseop-ro Street.
	Cheonjiyeon Falls	15:00~15:40	At Cheonjiyeon Falls, white water falls from the rock cliff and make a thundering sound. It gets its name because it means "sky connected with land." It is 22m high and 12m wide, and the view and the sound that the waters create when they fall is magnificent.
	Submarine Tour	15:40~17:20	The history of Jeju Island's submarine tours began in 1988. In 1988, Seogwipo Submarine became the 3rd in the world and the 1st in Asia to offer submarine tours at Seogwipo Munseom Island. Since 2003, the cutting edge tour submarine "Jiah", which was built in Finland and seats up to 67 people, is in operation so that more tourists may enjoy the chance to try out underwater tours as submarine tours become more widespread.
